STUDENT GUIDELINES FOR TAKING PACIFIC ISLANDS BIBLE COLLEGE COURSES BY DVD (READ FRONT AND BACK PAGE)

WHAT YOU ARE RECEIVING TO TAKE THIS COURSE BY DVD: 1.

- (1)Textbook to be read and studied with this course.
- (2) The DVDs for this course.
- (3) If a group is taking this course there will be a "Class Attendance Record" (Form 110) for keeping the class attendance record.
- (4) Exam or exams to be taken with this course.

2. WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO TAKE THIS COURSE BY DVD:

- Your time. (1)
- (2) Your Bible.
- A pen to underline and take notes. (3)

3. VERY IMPORTANT - HOW TO CARE FOR THE DVDS.

- (1)Do not drop the DVD.
- (2)Do not touch the bottom side of the DVD.
- (3) Do not scratch the bottom side of the DVD.
- Keep the bottom side of the DVD good and clean. Wipe with a SOFT damp cloth and then dry it with a **SOFT** cloth, if it is dirty.
- Do not put the DVD in direct sunlight. (5)
 - Always store the DVDs in the case provided.

4. MAKE A DECISION ON HOW YOU WILL TAKE THIS COURSE. HERE ARE SOME SUGGESTIONS FOR A TIME FOR TAKING THE COURSE:

- As an individual taking the course, you can take the course on your own time schedule.
- As a group, you can take the course Monday through Friday night for 15 nights.
- (3) As a group, you can take the course 1 night per week, the night that you prefer, for 15 weeks.
- (4) You will choose the hour of the day or days you will take the course.

5. REQUIREMENTS FOR TAKING THIS COURSE BY DVD.

- Read and study each page carefully in the textbook. (1)
- IF TAKING THE COURSE AS A GROUP: (2)
 - If taking the test in English, the administrator is to send in all tests for grading.

- B. If taking the test in the local language, the administrator must grade the tests, enter them on the "Class Attendance Record" (Form 110), and send in the "Class Attendance Record" sheet.
- (3) IF TAKING THE COURSE AS AN INDIVIDUAL:
 - A. We request that you take your exam without looking at your textbook, and that you set this exam before another Christian who will print their name, sign, and date the exam.
 - B. If taking the test in English, send in your test for grading.
 - C. If taking the test in the local language, ask one of the local Christian men to grade your test and you send in the results.

6. AT THE BEGINNING OF THE FIRST CLASS, THE PIBC ADMINISTRATOR MUST:

- (1) Hand out a sheet of paper for every student to print their name on for a roll. When the administrator goes home, he must put all names of students on the "Class Attendance Record" (Form 110).
- (2) Hand out the textbooks and encourage the students to study the lesson assigned for the next class.
- (3) If you are studying a course like "Acts" or some other books of the Bible, encourage the students to read that book in the Bible while you are taking the course.

7. AT THE FIRST CLASS OR VIEWING OF THE FIRST DVD, THE PIBC STUDENT OR ADMINISTRATOR MUST ENCOURAGE EVERYONE:

- (1) To use their Bible in taking the course.
- (2) To give close attention to what the video instructor teaches.
- (3) To study the next lesson from the textbook, reading all Scriptures.
- (4) To be on time for each class.

8. AT THE END OF EACH LESSON, THE STUDENT OR ADMINISTRATOR MUST:

- (1) Review the lesson in the student's local language.
- (2) Must remind the students:
 - A. To read and study the next lessons for the next DVD.
 - B. To do everything that the instructor requires on the DVD for the course in order to get the most from the course.
 - C. To study for taking the test at the end of the course.
 - D. To be faithful in doing this course on DVD just the same as they would be in any other class of learning.

9. AFTER COMPLETING YOUR PACIFIC ISLANDS BIBLE COLLEGE (PIBC) COURSE BY DVD:

- (1) You may keep your textbook for your own use.
- (2) You may keep the DVDs to use in the future.
- (3) Mail your exam to us in the envelope provided.
- (4) Write to us any comments or words that you would like for us to know.
