#### What is sin?

#### 1 John 3:4

Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness.

#### James 4:17

Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin.

#### **Matthew 15:18**

But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man.

#### Lists of some sins:

#### 1 Corinthians 6:9-10

9 Do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived. Neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor sodomites, 10 nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners will inherit the kingdom of God.

#### **Galatians 5:19-21**

19 Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, 20 idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, 21 envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

#### Colossians 3:5-9

5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. 6 Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, 7 in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them. 8 But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man with his deeds,

Sin includes doing something God condemns, not doing what God commands, and sinful thinking.

## Are we born in sin?

#### Romans 3:12

They have all gone out of the way; they have together become unprofitable; There is none who does good, no, not one."

## **Definitions:**

Unprofitable: not useful

Statutes: laws

**Iniquity:** guilt from sin

## Ezekiel 18:4, 9, 19, 20

- 4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sins, it shall die.
- 9 If he has walked in My statutes—And has kept My judgments faithfully—He is just; He shall surely live!" Says the Lord GOD.
- 19 Yet you say, Why does the son not bear the iniquity of the father? When the son has done that which is lawful and right, and has kept all my statutes, and has done them, he shall surely live.
- 20 The soul that sins it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be on him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be on him.

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;


## **Romans 5:12**

# What are the consequences of sin?

#### **James 1:15**

Then when lust has conceived, it brings forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, brings forth death.

#### Isaiah 59:1-2

1 Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: 2 But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear.



## **Definitions:**

Lust: to want something enough to sin

Conceived: to give birth to

**Iniquities**: sins
